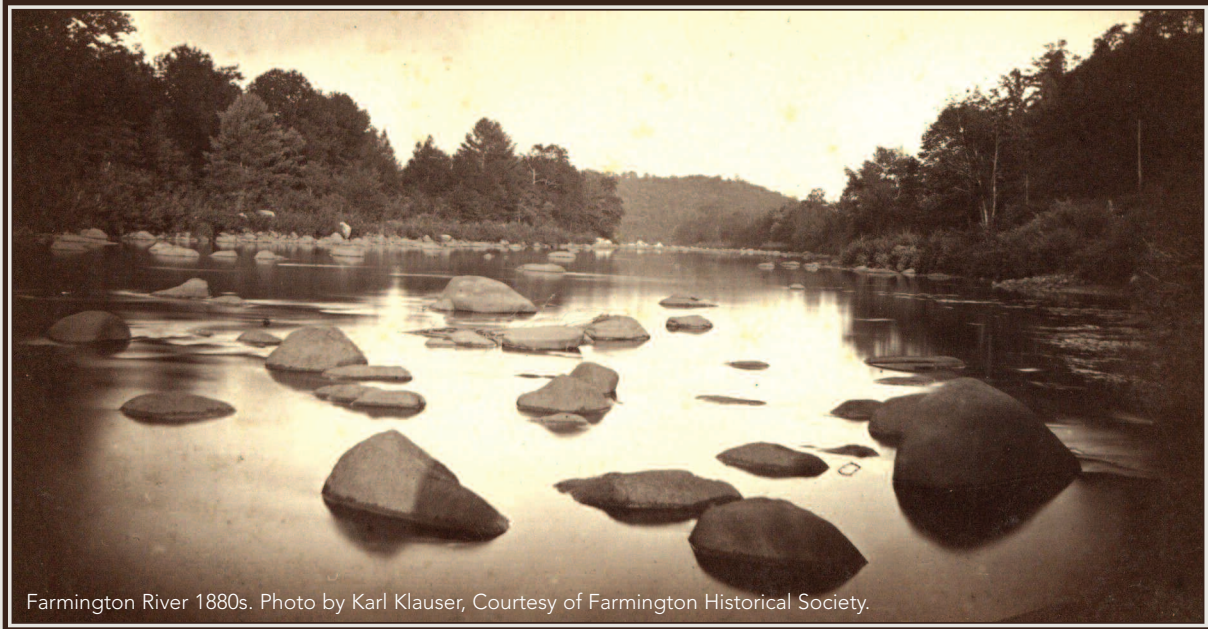


# The Farmington River: Currents Through Time
